Recent youth feedback sessions shared powerful ways this work lifted up participants' confidence, awareness and interconnectedness to peers and communities. OLAAI is building from this experience and has already applied one lesson into our community engagement strategy: pay youth 50% above minimum wage to engage in Lawndale activations like street festivals/community expos, recruiting peers to OLAAI's emerging programming, and living out- and celebrating- solidarity in action.
